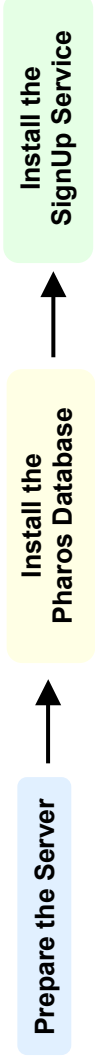




Pharos SignUp Vx Installation Guide

Installing Pharos SignUp Vx for the first time requires three basic steps:



Preparing the Server

Your primary Pharos server should be running one of the following operating systems, with the latest Service Pack:

- Windows NT 4 Server
- Windows 2000 Server
- Windows XP Professional

The server must also have installed:

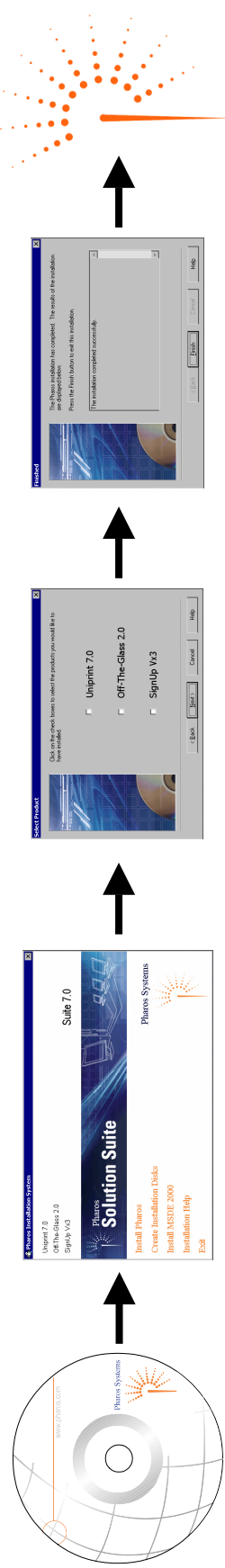
- Microsoft SQL Server 7 or SQL Server 2000, with the latest Service Pack. (If SQL Server is not available, MSDE can be installed from the Pharos CD.)
- TCP/IP networking.

Once the server is prepared, you are ready to begin installing SignUp Vx.

Installing the Pharos Database and Administration Tools

1. Insert the Pharos CD.
2. Select 'Install Pharos'.
3. Click <Next> at the Welcome screen.
4. At the Select Installation Mode screen, select 'Typical'.
5. Leave the Install Directory as the default.
6. Leave the Backup Files screen with its defaults.
7. At the Select Product screen, select 'SignUp'.
8. At the Select Role screen, select 'Principal Server'.
9. Select 'Yes' or 'No' depending on whether or not you want to install Pharos Surveyor.
10. Leave all components selected at the Components screen.
11. Select 'Yes' or 'No', depending on whether or not the site uses Card Readers or Online Billing Services. This affects the list of Card Readers and Logon DLLs presented on the next screen.

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Installing the Database continued...

12. At the License Details screen, supply the location of your registry file.
13. Enter your name and title, then read your license agreement. Click <End User Licensee Accept>. (You must scroll to the bottom of the license agreement to enable <End User Licensee Accept>.)
14. Specify where OSQL is. (If you did the default MSSQL install, the default will be correct.)
15. If Pharos is being installed on a machine running multiple instances of SQL Server 2000, one instance must be chosen to install the Database on.
16. Supply the SQL System Administrator Logon. If you did the default MSSQL install then User Name is 'sa', and Password is blank.
17. Schedule a backup to disk.
18. For the Level One Support Address, give the email address of the person or company from whom you bought your Pharos software.
19. Enter a name and password for the Administrator-level User (keep a note of these details).
20. Check the installation details displayed and click <Start>. The installation will commence. When it is done, click <Finish>.
21. Click <OK> to reboot when prompted.

Your machine now contains the Pharos Database, its related servers, and the **Pharos Administrator** application, so you can now manage all Pharos components running on your network.

Installing the Pharos SignUp Service

The SignUp Service can be installed on the same machine as the Database, or on a separate machine. Depending on the size of your organization, you may need multiple SignUp Services (each on a separate machine).

1. Insert the Pharos CD.
2. Select 'Install Pharos'.
3. Click <Next> at the Welcome screen.
4. Any Pharos components already installed on this machine will be displayed. Click <Next> to continue.
5. At the Select Installation Mode screen, select 'Typical'.
6. Leave the Install Directory as the default.
7. Leave the Backup Files screen with its defaults.
8. At the Select Product screen, select 'SignUp'.
9. At the Select Role screen, select 'SignUp Server'.
10. If any Pharos components are already installed on this machine, the Select Installation Option screen will be displayed. Select 'Install'.
11. Leave the selected components as they are at the Components screen. Click <Next> to continue.
12. Supply the name or TCP/IP address of the machine on which you installed the Pharos Database Server.
13. Check the installation details displayed and click <Start>. The installation will commence. When it is done, click <Finish>.
14. Click <OK> to reboot when prompted.

Congratulations! Your machine is now a fully configured Pharos server.

What next? Depending on how your system is set up, you may need to install **Pharos Stations**, the **Pharos Web Components** and **SignUp Clients**. See the SignUp Orientation Guide (available in the root directory of the Pharos CD), or the Pharos online Help for more information.

You will definitely need to configure your system with the **Pharos Administrator** application (installed with the Database). Open this application from the **Start menu > Pharos > Pharos**. See the Pharos online Help for more information on configuring your system.
